Thank you for your continued trust in Macha Eye Care. We are pleased to announce that we have reopened our offices after our closure due to COVID-19. We have missed seeing you and your family members. Our goal is to protect our patients, doctors, and staff, while providing excellent care and service that you are accustomed to. We have implemented many changes to accomplish this goal.

- All services require an appointment. These include exams, repairs, adjustments, or the purchase of eye wear at a time other than the day of your exam. We ask you to call us upon arrival of your appointment. We will be offering curbside service for adjustments, repairs, and dispensing of eye wear. Of course, complex situations will require that you come in to the building.
- Please be prompt to your appointment. Due to social distancing requirements, we will have to reschedule your appointment if you are more than 10 minutes late.
- Patients are encouraged to have intake forms completed prior to arrival. These can be found in the "Patient information" section. Please upload and email completed forms to contactus@machaeyecare.com. If unable to upload and email, we can complete this task directly upon arrival at the office.
- All staff will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 upon arrival to the office. Temperature and oxygen levels will be taken and documented daily.
- Patients must be in good health: no coughs, fever (99 degrees or more), oxygen level under 90, breathing issues, colds, other signs of COVID-19 or if you have been in contact with someone who has. If any of these conditions exist, you will be asked to reschedule. Temperature and oxygen levels will be taken prior to entering the office.
- We are limiting the number of patients in the office. Only one person allowed in the office per appointment. Minors or adults under guardianship may be accompanied by one other person. Both will be required to wash their hands upon entering the office.

- Front doors will remain locked. Patients will be let in and out of the office by a staff member.
- Both patients and staff will be required to wear face masks if they are over 2 years of age and having no breathing difficulties.
- All exam rooms, chairs, and equipment will be sanitized after every patient use.
- All frames that are tried on by patients will be sanitized before returning to the retail area.
